In the thirteenth chapter of First Corinthians, Paul lists some crucial things Christians need to heed about our love for one another. What chapter in the Bible is more fitting for A husband and wife to read together?

⁴ Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵ It does not dishonor others, it is not self -seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶ Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷ It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. I Cor. 13:4-7

God is love...who better to advise on ways to love and honor. Paul was writing to the Church in Corinthians, but husbands and wives can strengthen their relationship if this method is examined. Valentine's Day is a start. Make every day a day of love and honor.
