

A LIGHTHOUSE AND SCRIPTURE EXODUS 33:21-22



Lighthouses are painted differently to help identify the mariner during the day. For example, a lighthouse may be painted all white if its surroundings/background is dark, such as fields or woodland. This will help it stand out from its background. The red and white stripes help the mariner identify the lighthouse if the lighthouse is up against a white background, such as cliffs or rocks.

The two main purposes of a lighthouse are to serve as a navigational aid and to warn boats of dangerous areas. It is like a traffic sign on the sea.

Our Bible should project itself to Christians as a safe haven for those searching for a place to feel safe and secure. The Bible is a navigational map for us when we need travel directions for our Christian walk.

Warnings are found through the teachings of the apostles. Their writings warn of how the world can lead us on the wrong path in our journey.

Christians can be a lighthouse for someone searching for spiritual comfort. The world should look and see a Christian as a color and shape to be identified with Christ. Standing confidently in the safety of the cleft on a rocky shore. Our outline will show against the darkness of the world. Satan wants us to become lost in the background so we can't project the light of Christ.
